Time Limits per Speaker for Debates and Motivation

1. Motion maker's motivation for up to 90 seconds.
2. Board members may discuss for pro or con for 60 seconds.
3. Any other discussion should be limited to 60 seconds of speaking per member, with possible additional 60 second follow up after others have had a chance to speak.

Amended Motion for Election of KPFT LSB Members

Whereas Marianne Martinez has been a listener-representative to the KPFT LSB and has tendered her resignation from that position with immediate effectivity by email on 13 January 2026 and confirmed on 17 January 2026; and

Whereas Adriana Caseneve and Mike Lewis have reached the end of their term-limiting 6-years of consecutive KPFT LSB service in their respective classes; and

Whereas, Article 3, Section 12: Local Station Board (LSB) Transitions provides: “Vacancies on the LSBs occurring during the transition period are filled by LSB nominations and voting by secret ballot by those remaining members of the LSB with replacements according to their respective class and station.”

Therefore, the KPFT LSB will initiate the procedure to fill the unexpired terms of the two listener representative members and one staff representative member, as follows:

The election to these positions will be announced at the KPFT LSB meeting of January 21, 2026, posted on the KPFT Web Site and the KPFT Facebook page following the meeting and will be announced on air, with a deadline of candidate submissions to the KPFT LSB Secretary no later than midnight CT, Friday, February 6, 2026 who will then forward them to all LSB members;

Candidates will be invited to make statements at the KPFT LSB meeting on February 11, 2026;

The election will be held by OpaVote using Instant Runoff Voting for the single staff representative position and Single Transferable Voting for the two listener representative positions, with ballots issued on or about February 13, 2026 and due by midnight CT February 27, 2026, which deadline can be extended if quorum is not reached and results announced as soon as possible after the deadline.

Motion re: Public Comment Time Limits

Whereas the KPFT Local Station Board (LSB) seeks to make best use of its board meeting time; and

Whereas Pacifica’s bylaws require 30 minutes to be set aside for public comment, but do not indicate how that time is to be divided, allocated, or used;

Therefore, I move that speakers during the Public Comment period of the KPFT LSB meeting be allowed three minutes per turn, and no more than two turns (for a total of six minutes) be allowed per speaker, Rules for multiple speakers remain unchanged where everyone who wishes to speak and indicates that desire is allowed to speak before a previous speaker is allowed a second turn. During the interval when public comment is invited, if no speakers are available, given the rules as indicated, normal business of the KPFT LSB may continue.

Article 7, Section 5, sub C

“Each meeting shall include a public comment period of not less than thirty (30) minutes. No person shall be required, as a condition for attendance at any public meeting or to publicly comment, to register his/her name or to provide any other information.”
